A large scale ARC Linkage project has been funded to investigate Queensland's knowledge transfer system and the role of intermediaries in knowledge transfer and socioeconomic transformation. The project has industry partners including the Australian Institute for Commercialisation, QMI Solutions and the Queensland Rural Industries Training Council. The successful applicant will be based in the School of Management, QUT. The successful applicant will be involved in a range of research tasks including providing support with the collection and analysis of both quantitative and qualitative data in metropolitan, rural and regional Queensland. The applicant will be required to prepare written reports and presentations for the research team and engage in stakeholder liaison and relationship management. The main field of inquiry is knowledge transfer, diffusion and innovation with a view to broader socioeconomic outcomes.

Applicants are expected to have:

- A background in business studies, sociology or related discipline
- Knowledge of or experience with innovation research
- Skills in a variety of data collection and analysis techniques

Description of the scholarship:

The school is offering one APAI, PhD Scholarship to the value of \$25 627 per annum (tax exempt and indexed annually) for 3 years.
