Scholarship Description

THE COMMONWEALTH – GRENADA ST. GEORGES UNIVERSITY SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

SGU realizes the importance of offering academically gifted students, with limited resources, the ability to reach their potential. The University is pleased to confirm the continuation of **The Commonwealth – Grenada St. Georges University Scholarship Program (CGSC)** which was implemented in January 2007.

75 full tuition scholarships will be offered over 10 years to qualified students from Commonwealth countries. Preference will be given to students from developing countries and small states.

5 scholarship programs have been created under the umbrella of The Commonwealth-Grenada St. George's University Scholarship Program. They will benefit both graduate and undergraduate students who demonstrate academic excellence, financial need and a commitment to their chosen discipline.

Availability

75 full tuition scholarships will be offered over 10 years to qualified students from Commonwealth countries. Preference will be given to students from developing countries and small states. **Master in Public Health**

25 students selected, with special emphasis given to those who will dedicate their professional skills to the public health problems of their home countries.

Master of Business Administration

25 scholarships in business administration will deliver trained managers who will be able to help developing countries build effective infrastructures in business, industry and government. There will be an emphasis on international business and entrepreneurial skills and a concentration on public sector management and hotel/tourism management.

Undergraduate Degrees

10 scholarships in the School of Arts and Sciences will train professionals to enhance the business and educational infrastructure of Commonwealth countries, especially developing nations. Degree programs are offered in international business, management information technology, life sciences, and liberal arts.

Doctor of Veterinary Medicine

10 scholarships in veterinary medicine are designed to provide veterinary surgeons for Commonwealth countries in need of more veterinary medical professionals.

Doctor of Medicine

5 scholarships in medicine will provide well-trained doctors to enhance health care delivery in developing nations. These doctors will be well equipped not only to help individual patients, but to contribute to their nation's healthcare delivery systems as a whole.

Open for applications until September 15, 2008.

Payment Information

The value of this scholarship is unspecified (total may vary). This award is to be used for fees, if awarded the student must be able to fund full living and travel expenses

Research Information

Eligibility

Awards will only be made to resident citizens of Commonwealth countries who have been residents within the country for at least the previous 12 months prior to the application deadline. Applicants must be accepted to St. George's University. Applicants must be able to fund their living and travel expenses through their own personal resources or alternate funding sources.
