Project 1: Human Brain Mapping of Tinnitus and its Remediation

This project aims to assess the subjective changes in tinnitus throughout a tinnitus remediation program and correlate this with changes in cortical auditory activity measured objectively.

Project 2: Research the barriers and facilitators to successful hearing rehabilitation for older adults

The project will comprehensively examine the barriers and facilitators to successful hearing rehabilitation for adults with hearing impairment.

Project 3: Central Auditory Disabilities in Children with Language Impairment

The project aims to investigate and identify auditory processing abilities in children with Learning Impairment that may be contributing to problems with language and learning.
