

### Melbourne School of Engineering and Faculty of Science - Postgraduate Research Scholarships

#### Two scholarships valued at \$25,000 per year for 3.5 years.

Open to students enrolled in a higher degree by research who are undertaking research in a field related to Mining and Metallurgy in the Melbourne School of Engineering – Mechanical, Geomatics or Civil Engineering or the Faculty of Science in particular Earth Sciences or any other department offering subjects relevant to Mining and Metallurgy.

#### Background Information:

Miss Rebecca Rigg of East Malvern, Victoria who died on 14 May 1958 bequeathed part of her estate to the University for the promotion and encouragement of study and research in either Mining or Metallurgy. The scholarship is to be awarded annually to students enrolled in a higher degree by research who is undertaking research in a field related to Mining and Metallurgy in the department of Mechanical and Manufacturing Engineering, the department of Geomatics, the Department of Civil and Environmental Engineering, the School of Earth Sciences or any other department of the University that may offer subjects relevant to Mining and Metallurgy. The scholarship may be awarded as a traveling scholarship.

The scholarship is to be awarded annually by Council on the recommendation of the Dean of the Melbourne School of Engineering.

- A description of your research topic (1 page maximum);
