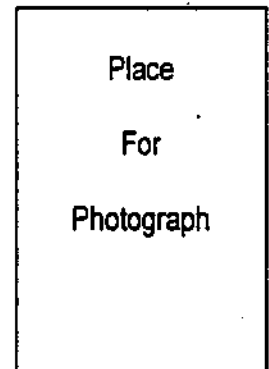

**DURATION AND TERMS OF THE SCHOLARSHIP**

1. Candidates should have their University degrees recognised by the Center for the Recognition of Foreign University Degrees (DI.KA.T.S.A., 223 Messogion Avenue, Athens 115 25, Tel:6756362 - 68 & 6756464 - 94, Fax:6756709), before applying for admission to a Greek University.

2. a. The scholarship for postgraduate / doctoral studies, or specialization in the Fine Arts begins after the candidate's arrival in Greece provided that he has (i) been accepted by a School of Modern Greek Language (the courses for Modern Greek Language usually commence in October – for further information you have to apply to the relevant Universities); and (ii) been admitted by a Greek University to pursue postgraduate / doctoral work or specialization in the Fine Arts - as proved by a formal letter issued by the relevant Department of that University.

b. For postdoctoral studies, the scholarship begins after the candidate's arrival in Greece, provided that a Greek University professor has accepted to cooperate with him during his postdoctoral research studies.

c. For further education studies in Greek Language, Literature, Philosophy and Art, the scholarship begins after the candidate's arrival in Greece, provided that a Greek University professor has accepted to supervise him during his research work.

In every case, the candidate is responsible for the commencement of his scholarship by providing the official documentation indicating his acceptance for postgraduate, doctoral, postdoctoral, specialization or research studies.

It is highly recommended that all scholars should bring an adequate amount of money to cover immediate needs

because due to standard procedures the first payment of the scholarship will be ready almost 3 weeks after their arrival in Greece and the submission of the required documents.

3. Details for the duration of the scholarship are mentioned in the announcement of the programme.

The scholarship is for consecutive months / years. No scholarship can start during the summer months.

Every semester (6 months) scholarship holders of all categories must submit to the I.K.Y. a studies report signed by their supervisor.

At the end of the first year the postgraduate / doctoral /specialized in the Fine Arts scholar has to submit to the I.K.Y.:

- a) A certificate from the school for Modern Greek Language that he has completed successfully the course.
- b) An annual studies report signed by his supervisor.
- c) An attestation from the relevant Department concerning the subject of the thesis and the three members supervisory committee (in case of doctoral scholars) or transcripts of the postgraduate courses (in case of postgraduate scholars) and
- d) A letter from the supervisor professor(s) recommending the renewal of the scholarship. In the following years the scholar has to submit to the I.K.Y. all the above except (a). Postgraduate scholars who wish to renew their scholarship for Ph.D., must submit their M.A. /M.Sc. and an admission letter in Ph.D.

Postdoctoral and further educations scholars should submit the document (d) at the end of the first semester.

The above are absolutely necessary for the renewal of the scholarship.

At the end of his studies programme, the scholarship holder must submit a detailed final report signed by his supervisor professor(s) and a validated copy of the academic title he has acquired, if any.

The terms and conditions of the scholarship are mentioned in detail in the relevant contract of the scholar with I.K.Y.

4. The scholarship holder will be deprived of his scholarship in any of the following cases:

- a) A false statement has been made on his application dossiers.
- b) He does not comply with the terms and conditions of the scholarship.
- c) He has been subjected to disciplinary action by the University or has no prospect for academic achievement e.g. failure to achievement a satisfactory level in the Greek language or in his major subjects.
- d) He leaves Greece regardless of the reason, with out having previously inform in writing the Foundation.

### FINANCIAL PROVISIONS

The scholarship includes:

- a. A monthly allowance of 150.000 drhs as an aid for living expenses. For postdoctoral researchers and professors from Greek Studies Departments abroad 200.000 drhs.  
The amount of the scholarship does not cover the full cost of living but it is a financial aid towards the scholar's monthly expenses. The estimated cost of living is 200.000 - 250.000 drhs per month approximately.
- b. 200.000 drhs for initial expenses.
- c. Stay permit dues.
- d. Exemption from tuition fees for the School of Modern Greek Language.
- e. Free medical care in case of emergency in public hospitals.

In addition, the scholarship for doctoral studies includes up to 80.000 drhs to cover typing and reproduction costs of the Ph.D. dissertation and up to 100.000 drhs to cover laboratory expenses, if these expenses are a mandatory part of the scholar's programme of studies.

- No support is provided for transportation, conferences, seminars, symposia or research activities.
- No additional assistance is provided for the wife/husband or other dependants of a scholarship holder.
- The scholarship holder is not permitted to undertake paid employment of any kind, as he is expected to devote himself fully to his studies.
- The scholarship will be withheld for periods spent outside Greece.

Scholarship holders must submit to the I.K.Y. a declaration that they commit themselves to return to their native countries and work there for at least five years; otherwise, they must pay back the total amount of the grant. The Greek
